DOE CORNWELL, 19 Defendants. 20 I, Spencer Nathan Thal, declare as follows: 21 I am the sole owner of Vanguard Law. I am admitted to practice before this Court 22 and am a member in good standing of the bar of the state of Washington and have been since my 23 admission in 1990. I respectfully submit this declaration in support of Plaintiffs' Unopposed Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement and Attorneys' Fees and Costs. I have 24

personal knowledge of the facts and am competent to testify before a court of law.

- 2. I have been actively practicing in labor and employment law for the entire duration of my 35 years, most of it representing unions and workers. I spent the majority of that time working as an in-house attorney for various labor unions. Unions are by their very nature collective organizations of workers. In my role as an in-house attorney, I had countless opportunities to assess the best interest of the class of workers of the bargaining unit through grievances, contract negotiation, and litigation.
- 3. I formed Vanguard Law almost ten years ago. A significant portion of Vanguard Law's caseload is employment litigation, both discrimination and wage and hour litigation. We also are involved with personal injury litigation.
- 4. I have been involved in one other class action: *Weza v. Fastenal Company*, Pierce County Superior Court Case No. 13-2-07444-9.
- 5. Zachariah ("Zach") Thal is an attorney and my son. He worked for Vanguard Law first in 2018 as a Rule 9 intern, and then as an associate attorney on May 1, 2019. He passed the bar later that year. He has been an employee of Vanguard Law continuously since that time working on all aspects of Vanguard Law's litigation practice.
- 6. Zach and I were both involved in the litigation from its inception. We interviewed Plaintiffs, investigated the underlying facts, and researched the potential legal claims before drafting and filing the initial complaint to toll the statute of limitations. Once the complaint was on file and the maximum damages for Plaintiffs and proposed class members were preserved, we actively sought out co-counsel with class action experience to join the case. After Terrell Marshall Law Group agreed to join, the two firms worked together to further investigate the classwide claims and draft an amended complaint that joined Defendant Earnest Cornwell.
- 7. Zach and I contributed to case strategy throughout the litigation, engaged in premediation discussions, and assisted with informal discovery. We also participated in the full-day mediation and following negotiations that led to the settlement agreement. Based on our participation and evaluation of the strengths and weaknesses of the case, we believe the settlement

is fair, reasonable, adequate, and in the best interests of the Settlement Class and that it demonstrates a strong result under the circumstances.

- 8. Vanguard Law has incurred costs of \$241.50 for court filing fees. Such costs were reasonable and necessary to this litigation and the type of cost that would normally be charged to a paying client.
- 9. To date, Vanguard Law has invested more than 59.52 hours into the investigation and litigation of this case. Since its inception, Vanguard Law has worked with no guarantee of being compensated for its time and efforts, with payment of its fees being contingent on successfully obtaining relief for Plaintiffs and Settlement Class Members. As a result, there was substantial risk of non-payment, particularly in light of the challenges inherent in this type of case. Therefore, by necessity, work in this case has been done to the exclusion of work in other matters that likely would have generated fees.
- 10. Vanguard Law's rates are based on reasonable hourly rates, set for attorneys and staff members based on a variety of factors including, among others: the experience and skill required for these types of legal services; the complexity and sophistication required to perform these services; the customary local market rate of such legal services; and the experience, reputation, and ability of the attorneys and staff members.
- 11. In addition to Zach and myself, our paralegal Sophia Stephens also worked on this case. The work performed by Sophia was work that Zach or I would have had to perform absent such assistance. Sophia is qualified to perform substantial legal work in her practice as a paralegal based on her education, training, and experience.
- 12. Attorney Spencer Nathan Thal. Principal. J.D. from Columbia Law School 1990. Rate: \$375. Hours: 37.15. Total fees: \$13,931.25. Work performed: Investigated and analyzed factual background; researched and analyzed legal issues and claims; drafted and filed the initial complaint to stop the statute of limitations; secured experienced class counsel; worked on draft

amended complaint adding claims and defendants; participated in mediation; and worked on motions for preliminary and final approval.

- 13. Attorney Zachariah Thal. Associate. J.D. from University of Washington School of Law 2019. Rate: \$250. Hours 13.60. Total fees: \$3,400.00. Work performed: Consultation and strategizing with co-counsel, legal research, document review, and preparation and participation in the full-day mediation.
- 14. Paralegal Sophia Stephens. 5 years of experience as a paralegal. Rate: \$125. Hours: 8.77. Total fees: \$1,096.25. Work performed: Document review and organization, communications with attorney.
  - 15. The total fees requested by Vanguard Law are \$18,427.50.
- 16. Vanguard Law will spend additional hours finalizing the resolution of this case. I anticipate the firm will incur additional fees in relation to the approval and settlement administration process.
